Measure #3: Candidate competency at program completion

The MDEEL (EPP) program collects data from candidates at program completion demonstrating the candidates' ability to be recommended for licensure as related to their program of study. Puerto Rico does not require a licensing exam for school principals. To be recommended for licensure candidates must complete the following to demonstrate their competency at the end of their program of study.

1. ***Program Grade Point Average-*** program graduates must complete all programs with a minimum of a 3.0 grade point average (GPA) in order to be recommended for licensure as School Principals.
2. ***Program Assessments-*** Candidates must successfully complete all program assessments demonstrating competency in the CAEP, NELP, and Puerto Rico standards.
3. ***Internship candidates-*** must successfully complete the 2-term internship demonstrating competency in all the NELP standards.
